Sara Moorhouse

Sara Moorhouse is a ceramicist who experiments with the way colour can alter special perception, a phenomenon she first noticed in the agricultural landscapes of Wales. In 2017 Moorhouse was included in Compton Verney's exhibition Seurat to Riley: The Art of Perception, Pattern, Pointillism and Op Art (also touring to Holburne Museum, Bath). In 2014 Moorhouse won the Creative Wales Award and used it to make her St. Ives collection of bowls. We are now showing bowls from her new Colourblock series, both as individual pieces and as a 16 bowl wall mounted work. In this piece the viewer is invited to look into the interiors, to see if lines connect through negative space and across the bowls – an innovative departure from Moorhouse's horizontal bands.


